Introduction

This is the first formal year report of the Mendel Foundation, pertaining to the extended period from its formal foundation on Dec 19th, 2012 up to the end of 2013.

This period was characterized by a lot of good intentions (of which just a limited amount came to realization); and the start of Mrs. Drs. Caroline 't Hooft, "Maître d'Officine", which eventually lead to the elaboration of some important, groundbreaking issues.

The year 2013 was dominated by the extremely overflowing agenda of ACHg in favor of Mendel Reva; we hope and expect that there will be considerably more time (and money) for the Mendel Foundation in 2014.

Mendel Foundation: brief profile

The initiators of this foundation are of the opinion that the current system of care and cure for the elderly is failing; that it lacks an emphasis on prevention and self-involvement: we can do better, together! The Mendel Foundation has put it as its goal, to make it possible for all individuals in their so-called Golden Age, to

Live at least seven extra years, as healthy and as glorious as ever possible!

The Mendel Foundation is an "Algemeen Nut Beogende Stichting", the Dutch version of a Not-For Profit NGO. It is the center of all Mendel-organizations, including (until the end of 2014)) Mendel Reva (which is currently being dismantled), Mendel Medical B.V. and the Mendel Society (in development).

The Mendel Foundation is the 'Brain and Conscience' of all Mendel- organizations. Here, we develop the systematics for optimal, respectful care for elderly at a Top Quality level, with special emphasis on prevention and *well-being*. The Foundation is an open platform that shares everything we develop freely; just as important, we guard and supervise the philosophy, content and quality of it all.

Relationship with the other Mendel entities, i.e. Mendel Rehab

The Mendel Foundation has contributed substantially in the systematics of both Mendel Reva and Aratame, mostly in providing structured model-documents: the intake/treatment plan, the document to be used in team meetings and several model documents for patient- correspondence, which were adopted in both organizations. As meant to be, the Mendel Foundation is named in the footnote of every document.

These standard documents still need to be translated in Spanish and English, and made available on the website under "Downloads".

On sept 21st, 2013 we celebrated a unique mutual assembly meeting, bringing together both the directors and the Supervisory Boards of the Mendel Foundation and Mendel Reva. Unfortunately, in the end, of Mendel Reva only one member of the directory board (apart from ACHg) and none of the members of the Supervisory Board were present. Thus, we could only take very limited advantage of this opportunity to get introduced and to brainstorm about further collaboration on different levels.

The “Maître d’O”: Mrs. Drs. Caroline ‘t Hooft

The Maître d’Officine started her work with us on Aug 19th, 2013 as an independent professional contractor.

She channels, organizes, plans and elaborates “everything”; she manages, in the broadest sense, our (virtual) office.

By now, she contributed a lot, a.o. in the further development of the new website for the Mendel Foundation, along with different organizational tasks like the organization of two paramount meetings (one joint meeting of the management staffs and the Supervisory Boards of both the Mendel Foundation and Mendel Reva, and the Year’s End Meeting of the Mendel Foundation) .
